3. Understand that I shall be responsible for ensuring that the student adheres to the College's rules and regulations. In particular, I will advise the student that they may not buy alcohol or enter licensed premises.
4. Agree that, if the student is unable to consent and if it is not possible to contact a parent or legal guardian, the College may authorise emergency medical treatment acting on medical advice in the best interests of the student.
5. Accept that the College's obligation of confidentiality is owed to the student and to nobody else. Accordingly, the College shall not divulge confidential information to a parent or anyone else without the consent of the student.
6. Understand that this Declaration shall remain in force until the student's eighteenth birthday.
