Using the Library

Membership

Staff and apprentices from the NHS trusts that have agreements with Imperial College London Library can join with full or reference membership, depending on eligibility. Students on placement in those Trusts are also eligible to join.

- To apply for library membership, complete our online registration form at www.imperial.ac.uk/library/use-the-library/membership/nhs
- We will provide you with a login for accessing the Library's PCs, the College WiFi and your library account
- As a member you can use any of our libraries
- If you have an honorary contract at Imperial College London you have already been automatically registered with the Library and can access services using their Imperial College London ID card

Borrowing

- You can borrow up to 20 items*
- Items are issued for 3 weeks* and will be automatically renewed for up to 12 months
- If an item you have is requested by someone else, you will need to return it by the latest due date
- We only charge fines for the late return of items that have been requested by another reader
- You can borrow and return at any of our libraries
- If the item you want is held at another Imperial library, you can request it and have it delivered to the library of your choice

*Placement students can borrow up to 5 items for one week.

NHS Knowledge and Library Hub

The NHS Knowledge and Library Hub is your gateway to online resources. The Hub connects you to high-quality knowledge and evidence, including:

- journals and databases, e.g. MEDLINE, CINAHL and Trip Pro
- e-books, e.g. Kortext, Oxford Medicine Online and Maudsley Prescribing Guidelines
- clinical decision support resources, e.g. NICE Guidelines, BMJ Best Practice and Royal Marsden Manual
- policy and management information and research

Finding articles via the Hub is easy. With one click you can get the full text or place a request if instant access is not available.
