DIRECTOR OF THE GRADUATE SCHOOL OF LIFE SCIENCES AND MEDICINE AND THE SCHOOL OF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Professor Andrew George, Professor of Molecular Immunology in the Department of Medicine, has accepted appointment as Director of the Graduate School of Life Sciences and Medicine and the School of Professional Development with effect from 13 February 2010. He will succeed Professor Bernard Morley who will be leaving Imperial to take up the position of Pro-Vice-Chancellor (Learning & Teaching) at the University of Bath.

Professor George joined the former Royal Postgraduate Medical School as a lecturer in 1992. His research has sought to understand and manipulate the immune system in order to treat disease, in particular to prevent the rejection of transplanted organs. He is currently Head of Science BSc courses for the Faculty of Medicine and has received two Imperial College London Awards for Excellence in Teaching for his contributions to education, including postgraduate taught courses and research degrees. Professor George is Chair of the UK's National Research Ethics Advisory Panel.
