GRANTHAM INSTITUTE – CLIMATE CHANGE AND THE ENVIRONMENT

Professor Joanna Haigh CBE FRS and Professor Martin Siegert have accepted appointment as Co-Directors of the renamed Grantham Institute - Climate Change and the Environment (formerly the Grantham Institute for Climate Change). The appointments are for five years, with effect from 1 May 2014, and are part-time positions, equivalent to 60% of full time employment.

Professor Haigh has been the Head of the Department of Physics since January 2009. Professor Jordan Nash is now taking up appointment as her successor on 1 May. Alongside her new appointment, she will continue her research in the Department of Physics as Professor of Atmospheric Physics.

Professor Siegert will become Professor of Geosciences in the Department of Earth Science and Engineering at Imperial alongside his new Co-Directorship. He joins Imperial from the University of Bristol where he is currently Director of Bristol Glaciology Centre and Professor of Geosciences. Prior to this, he was Head of the School of Geosciences and Assistant Principal for Energy and Climate Change at the University of Edinburgh.

Professor Sir Brian Hoskins CBE FRS, currently the Director of the Grantham Institute for Climate Change, will become Chair of the Grantham Institute - Climate Change and the Environment.
