HEAD OF UNDERGRADUATE MEDICINE

Dr Amir Sam, Clinical Reader in Endocrinology in the Department of Metabolism, Digestion and Reproduction, has accepted appointment as Head of Undergraduate Medicine with effect from 1 January 2020 for an initial period of three years.

Reporting to the Vice Dean (Education) for the Faculty of Medicine, Dr Sam will be responsible for the efficient and effective management of the undergraduate medicine courses.

Dr Sam joined the College in 2008 as a Clinical Research Fellow, and was appointed as Clinical Reader in Endocrinology in 2016. A consultant physician and endocrinologist, he has held positions including Director of Clinical Studies at Charing Cross Hospital, and has most recently been the School of Medicine's Director of Assessment. He has also held senior positions at both the Medical Schools Council and at the General Medical Council.

Dr Sam's research interests include medical education, diabetes and endocrinology.
