### **VICE-PROVOST (EDUCATION AND STUDENT EXPERIENCE)**

Professor Emma McCoy has accepted appointment as Vice-Provost (Education and Student Experience) from 1 August 2021, for a term of office of five years. Professor McCoy is currently Interim Vice-Provost (Education and Student Experience), a role she has held since 1 July 2020, and in which she has led the College's educational mission throughout the pandemic.

Working closely and collaboratively with key colleagues, in this role Professor McCoy is responsible for leading the delivery of the College's strategic aims for the provision of a world-class education for its students, the enrichment of its student experience and for delivering an 'Imperial education' which reflects the College's dynamic and enterprising culture. She is responsible for enhancing the quality, impact, coordination and delivery of education at the College.

Professor McCoy was appointed as a Lecturer in the Department of Mathematics in 1996 and was promoted to Senior Lecturer in 2005 and Professor in 2014. She was previously Vice-Dean (Education) for the Faculty of Natural Sciences, and Deputy Head and Interim Head of the Department of Mathematics.

Professor McCoy's research interests include Time Series, Wavelets and Causal Interference, with a particular interest in Transport Studies. She is a Fellow of the Institute for Mathematics and its Applications and a Fellow of the Royal Statistical Society.
