

A Quick Guide to the Learning & Teaching Development Programme

The LTDP consists of 5 core requirements, all of which must be completed, unless a participant has been signed off by their Head of Department as being exempt:



Compulsory EDU Workshops x 4:

- Introduction to Teaching for Learning
- Fundamentals Supervising PhD Students
- Introduction to Personal Tutoring

We also recommend that participants complete the following to prepare them for their HEA Application submission:

- STAR Introductory Workshop



Compulsory FoNS Workshops x 4:

- FoNS Workshop 1 - Departmental Teaching Practices
- FoNS Workshop 2 - Lecturing Skills
- FoNS Workshop 3 - Learning Technologies for Teaching
- FoNS Workshop 4 - Designing for Learning
