

Dr Victor Phillip Dahdaleh Graduate Fellowship

The National Heart and Lung Institute (NHLI) is pleased to announce the Dr Victor Phillip Dahdaleh Graduate Fellowship, as part of the Dr Victor Phillip Dahdaleh Graduate Centre for Respiratory and Cardiac Sciences. This fellowship offers an exceptional opportunity for aspiring researchers to contribute to innovative work in respiratory and cardiac sciences at NHLI.

Eligibility: Open for **home** non-clinical students and intercalated clinical students undertaking an MBPhD (Please note that this scheme is not open to Resident Doctors wishing to undertake a PhD).

Tuition fees: Full coverage at **home** rate

Stipend: £22,780 per annum, aligned with the [UKRI rate](#)

Consumables: £5,000 per annum for three years

Number of awards: One fellowship available

Start date: January or February 2026

Application deadline: Monday 3rd November 2025

Location: Hammersmith or Royal Brompton Campus

Application process:

Applicants must hold, or expect to obtain, a first or upper second-class undergraduate degree or UK equivalent, along with a Masters, both in an appropriate subject from a recognised academic institution. Kindly mention this fellowship as your **funding source in your application**. Your application will be considered by the panel shortly after the application deadline.

Interested candidates should identify and contact their potential supervisor as well as submit their PhD applications through Imperial College London official application portal: [Applying for a PhD or MD\(Res\) | Faculty of Medicine | Imperial College London](#). A research proposal **must** be submitted as part of this application if you would like to be considered for this fellowship. Shortlisted candidates will be invited to interview shortly after the application deadline.

Please note that prior applicants to this fellowship scheme are **not eligible** to reapply.
